His Destiny is Your Destiny

Isaiah 9:6 For unto us a child is born, unto us a son is given: and the government shall be upon his shoulder: and his name shall be called Wonderful, Counsellor, The mighty God, The everlasting Father, The Prince of Peace. Tof the increase of his government and peace there shall be no end, upon the throne of David, and upon his kingdom, to order it, and to establish it with judgment and with justice from henceforth even for ever. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this.

Text: The greatest gift of all keeps on giving! God has spoken His will and is fulfilling of it from before Creation.

Our Father God orchestrated both Jesus' birth and destiny as well as yours.

As we study God's Word we will see the how the birth of the Lamb of God, destined to redeem man, is now being fulfilled through you!

1. God orchestrates all: Jesus / You

Eph 1:11 In whom also we have obtained an inheritance, being predestinated according to the purpose of him who worketh all things after the counsel of his own will:

God orchestrates Rome to tax all Judea to get Jesus' birth in Bethlehem to fulfilled His prophecy!

Micah 5:2 But thou, Bethlehem Ephratah, though thou be little among the thousands of Judah, yet out of thee shall he come forth unto me that is to be ruler in Israel; whose goings forth have been from of old, from everlasting.

- You were born to the correct family in the exact location according to His purpose and grace before creation to fulfill your calling!
- 2 Tim 1:9 Who hath saved us, and called us with an holy calling, not according to our works, but according to his own purpose and grace, which was given us in Christ Jesus before the world began,
 - 2. Mary receives / You receive
- MARY RECEIVES Luke 1:30 And the angel said unto her, Fear not, Mary: for thou hast found favour with God. 31 And, behold, thou shalt conceive in thy womb, and bring forth a son, and shalt call his name JESUS. 32 He shall be great, and shall be called the Son of the Highest: and the Lord God shall give unto him the throne of his father David: 33 And he shall reign over the house of Jacob for ever; and of his kingdom there shall be no end. 34 Then said Mary unto the angel, How shall this be, seeing I know not a man? 35 And the angel answered and said unto her, The Holy Ghost shall come upon thee, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow thee: therefore also that holy thing which shall be born of thee shall be called the Son of God. 36 And, behold, thy cousin Elisabeth, she hath also conceived a son in her old age: and this is the sixth month with her, who was called barren. 37 For with God nothing shall be impossible. 38 And Mary said, Behold the handmaid of the Lord; be it unto me according to thy word. And the angel departed from her.

YOU RECEIVE - John 1:12 But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name: 13 Which were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.

- 3. Angels with Jesus / You
- JESUS' ANGELS Luke 2:8 And there were in the same country shepherds abiding in the field, keeping watch over their flock by night. And, lo, the angel of the Lord came upon them, and the glory of the Lord shone round about them: and they were sore afraid. And the angel said unto them, Fear not: for, behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy, which shall be to all people. There unto you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, which is Christ the Lord. And this shall be a sign unto you; Ye shall find the babe wrapped in swaddling clothes, lying in a manger. And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God, and saying, Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward men.
- YOUR ANGELS Matthew 18:10 Take heed that ye despise not one of these little ones; for I say unto you,

 That in heaven their angels do always behold the face of my Father which is in heaven. " For the Son of man is come to save that which was lost.

- 4. Jesus' Birth / Your birth & New Birth
- <u>JESUS' BIRTH</u> John 1:14 And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.
- YOUR TWO BIRTHS Gal 1:15 But when it pleased God, who separated me from my mother's womb, and called me by his grace, ¹⁶ To reveal his Son in me, that I might preach Him among the heathen; immediately I conferred not with flesh and blood:
- 1 Peter 1:23 Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible, by the word of God, which liveth and abideth for ever.
- 5. The region of influence Jesus / You
 - The footprints of Jesus were an arc of about 15 miles. His purpose was fulfilled! The Devil and his kingdom were defeated, all mankind was redeemed by Jesus' sacrifice, all that received Him (Jesus) were born again, and God received Billions of people to manifest His Son through them!
 - Your region of influence may seem similar to Jesus and those you touch through the Gospel of Jesus multiplies to the glory of God!
 - 6. His purpose / Your purpose
 - A. To seek and save the lost
- JESUS SAVES Luke 19:10 For the Son of man is come to seek and to save that which was lost.
- YOU SAVE 2 Cor 5:18 And all things are of God, who hath reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ, and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation; ¹⁹ To wit, that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation.
 - B. Destroy the works of the enemy
- <u>JESUS CONQUERED</u> 1 John 3:8 --- For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil.
- YOU CONQUER Heb 10:12 But this man, after he had offered one sacrifice for sins for ever, sat down on the right hand of God; ¹³ From henceforth expecting till his enemies be made his footstool.
- 2 Cor 10:3-5 and Eph 6:10-18
 - 7. Jesus' light / Your light
- <u>JESUS' LIGHT</u> John 8:12 Then spake Jesus again unto them, saying, I am the light of the world: he that followeth me shall not walk in darkness, but shall have the light of life.
- YOUR LIGHT Matthew 5:13 Ye are the salt of the earth: but if the salt have lost his savour, wherewith shall it be salted? it is thenceforth good for nothing, but to be cast out, and to be trodden under foot of men. 14 Ye are the light of the world. A city that is set on an hill cannot be hid. 15 Neither do men light a candle, and put it under a bushel, but on a candlestick; and it giveth light unto all that are in the house. 16 Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works, and glorify your Father which is in heaven.
- Wise men fall down and Worship God: Your first fruits, tithes, offerings and sacrifices.
- Matthew 2:1 Now when Jesus was born in Bethlehem of Judaea in the days of Herod the king, behold, there came wise men from the east to Jerusalem, ² Saying, Where is he that is born King of the Jews? for we have seen his star in the east, and are come to worship him.
- --- ¹¹ And when they were come into the house, they saw the young child with Mary his mother, and fell down, and worshipped him: and when they had opened their treasures, they presented unto him gifts; gold, and frankincense, and myrrh.
