### **Covenant Authority**

Text: Proverbs 18:20 A man's belly shall be satisfied with the fruit of his mouth; and with the increase of his lips shall he be filled. <sup>21</sup> Death and life are in the power of the tongue: and they that love it shall eat the fruit thereof. <sup>22</sup> Whoso findeth a wife findeth a good thing, and obtaineth favour of the LORD.
