## Communion

Matthew 24:1 And Jesus went out, and departed from the temple: and his disciples came to him for to shew him the buildings of the temple.<sup>2</sup> And Jesus said unto them, See ye not all these things? verily I say unto you, There shall not be left here one stone upon another, that shall not be thrown down.<sup>3</sup> And as he sat upon the mount of Olives, the disciples came unto him privately, saying, Tell us, when shall these things be? and what shall be the sign of thy coming, and of the end of the world?<sup>4</sup> And Jesus answered and said unto them, Take heed that no man deceive you. <sup>5</sup> For many shall come in my name, saying, I am Christ; and shall deceive many.<sup>6</sup> And ye shall hear of wars and rumours of wars: see that ye be not troubled: for all these things must come to pass, but the end is not yet.<sup>7</sup> For nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom: and there shall be famines, and pestilences, and earthquakes, in divers places.<sup>8</sup> All these are the beginning of sorrows.<sup>9</sup> Then shall they deliver you up to be afflicted, and shall kill you: and ye shall be hated of all nations for my name's sake.<sup>10</sup> And then shall many be offended, and shall betray one another, and shall hate one another.<sup>11</sup> And many false prophets shall rise, and shall deceive many.<sup>12</sup> And because iniquity shall abound, the love of many shall wax cold.<sup>13</sup> But he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved.<sup>14</sup> And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come.

Jesus spoke prophetically about the temple being destroyed in 67-70 AD, then of wars, rumors of wars, famines, pestilences (pandemics), earthquakes, people offended, betraying and hating one another, false religious leaders, many will be deceived, sin abounding, and coldhearted people = <u>All these are the beginning of sorrows.</u>

Jesus commanded: See that you are not troubled (disturbed, frightened)

# **Matthew 24:13** But he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved. <sup>14</sup> And this gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in all the world for a witness unto all nations; and then shall the end come.

## Jesus commanded:

1. Do not be troubled!

2. The Gospel of the Kingdom of God SHALL BE PREACHED! Then the end shall come.

Pray for peace in Israel!

## Pray for the Lord to send forth laborers!

**Communion: 1 Corinthians 11:23** For I have received of the Lord that which also I delivered unto you, That the Lord Jesus the same night in which he was betrayed took bread: <sup>24</sup> And when he had given thanks, he brake it, and said, Take, eat: this is my body, which is broken for you: this do in remembrance of me. <sup>25</sup> After the same manner also he took the cup, when he had supped, saying, This cup is the new testament in my blood: this do ye, as oft as ye drink it, in remembrance of me. <sup>26</sup> For as often as ye eat this bread, and drink this cup, ye do shew the Lord's death till he come. <sup>27</sup> Wherefore whosoever shall eat this bread, and drink this cup of the Lord, unworthily, shall be guilty of the body and blood of the Lord. <sup>28</sup> But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of that bread, and drink of that cup. <sup>29</sup> For he that eateth and drinketh unworthily, eateth and drinketh damnation to himself, not discerning the Lord's body. <sup>30</sup> For this cause many are weak and sickly among you, and many sleep. <sup>31</sup> For if we would judge ourselves, we should not be judged. <sup>32</sup> But when we are judged, we are chastened of the Lord, that we should not be condemned with the world.

- Examine yourself that you are the product of Jesus perfect sacrifice!
- Be bold with God through Jesus blood and body!

**Hebrews 10:19** *Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the holiest by the blood of Jesus,* <sup>20</sup> *By a new and living way, which he hath consecrated for us, through the veil, that is to say, his flesh;* 

**Hebrews 4:16** *Let us therefore come boldly unto the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy, and find grace to help in time of need.* 

## Jesus' Blood:

- Covenant with God Hebrews 10:16-23
- Authority over the enemy Revelation 12:10 And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of his Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night. <sup>11</sup> And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death.
- Forgiven and forgiving other's sins Matthew 26:28 For this is my blood of the new testament, which is shed for many for the remission of sins.

Jesus' Body:

- Died to end sin Romans 6:6-14 Romans 6:6 Knowing this, that our old man is crucified with him, that the body of sin might be destroyed, that henceforth we should not serve sin.<sup>7</sup> For he that is dead is freed from sin.
- Sickness Isaiah 53:4-13, 1 Peter 2:24 Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed.
- The law Galatians 2:19 For I through the law am dead to the law, that I might live unto God.
- Self Galatians 2:20 I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me.
- Worldliness 2 Corinthians 8:9 (Crucified to the world and the world to you!) 1 John 2:16 For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world.
- **Curse of the law Galatians 3:13** *Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, being made a curse for us: for it is written, Cursed is every one that hangeth on a tree:*
- **Poverty 2 Corinthians 8:9** For ye know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that, though he was rich, yet for your sakes he became poor, that ye through his poverty might be rich.

## Worship God with your first-fruits, tithes, offerings, and sacrifices:

John 4:34 Jesus saith unto them, My meat is to do the will of him that sent me, and to finish his work.

Malachi 3:10 Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house, and prove me now herewith, saith the LORD of hosts, if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it. <sup>11</sup> And I will rebuke the devourer for your sakes, and he shall not destroy the fruits of your ground; neither shall your vine cast her fruit before the time in the field, saith the LORD of hosts. <sup>12</sup> And all nations shall call you blessed: for ye shall be a delightsome land, saith the LORD of hosts.
