

**Palm Sunday 2022 - Receive Double!**  
**Jesus' Cross/Resurrection and The Holy Spirit in Power!**

**Zechariah 9:9** *Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion; shout, Oh daughter of Jerusalem: behold, thy King cometh unto thee: he is just, and having salvation; lowly, and riding upon an ass, and upon a colt the foal of an ass. <sup>10</sup>And I will cut off the chariot from Ephraim, and the horse from Jerusalem, and the battle bow shall be cut off; and He shall speak peace unto the heathen: and His dominion shall be from sea even to sea, and from the river even to the ends of the earth. <sup>11</sup>As for thee also, by the blood of thy covenant I have sent forth thy prisoners out of the pit wherein is no water. <sup>12</sup>Turn you to the strong hold, ye prisoners of hope: even today do I declare that I will render double unto thee;*

**Introduction:** The week of His Passion begins today! Thursday, Jesus was betrayed. Friday Jesus was Crucified. Sunday, the King of Kings and Lord of Lords was raised in Power. We are called to receive double! The full benefits of Jesus' Cross and Resurrection manifested by the Holy Spirit's Power!

**Good Friday: 7:00 PM - WORSHIP & POWER** – Experience His Power with Communion!

**Resurrection Sunday: 6:00 AM - SONRISE SERVICE 9:00 & 11:00AM – CELEBRATION!**

**Preparation for Passover:** During the time of Passover from all the countryside and the countries, all would congregate in Jerusalem, swelling from an average population of 50,000 to about 150,000. The city was packed bustling with activity! Whenever a city grows 3x its size there is abundance of business on all fronts including the temple business.

- **Man expected the Kingdom of God NOW!**

**Luke 19:11** *And as they heard these things, he added and spake a parable, because he was nigh to Jerusalem, and because they thought that the kingdom of God should immediately appear:*

- **Chief Priests and Pharisees plot to kill Jesus and Lazarus**

**John 11:55-57** *And the Jews' passover was nigh at hand: and many went out of the country up to Jerusalem before the passover, to purify themselves. Then sought they for Jesus, and spake among themselves, as they stood in the temple, "What think ye, that he will not come to the feast?" Now both the chief priests and the Pharisees had given a commandment, that, if any man knew where he were, he should show it, that they might take him.===*

**John 12:10** *But the chief priests consulted that they might put Lazarus also to death; <sup>11</sup>Because that by reason of him many of the Jews went away, and believed on Jesus.*

- **Palm Sunday is the triumphant entry.** It is God's presentation of the Paschal Lamb. The ancient Egyptians worshipped lambs. Taking a lamb, the Egyptians deity, into their homes for four days, with the intention of slaughtering and eating it, was an act that was sure to be noticed by the Egyptians. It was extremely likely that they would be infuriated by this disrespect of their god. The lamb's feet could not touch the ground! **This day the Perfect Lamb of God is coming down the Mount of Olives into His City/His Temple and even the donkey's hoof is not touching the ground coming down the Mount of Olives.**

**Zech 14:4** *And his feet shall stand in that day upon the mount of Olives, which is before Jerusalem on the east -*

**Christ our Passover! - 1 Corinthians 5:7** *Purge out therefore the old leaven, that ye may be a new lump, as ye are unleavened. For even Christ our passover is sacrificed for us:*

**Exodus 12:3** *Speak ye unto all the congregation of Israel, saying, In the tenth day of this month they shall take to them every man a lamb, according to the house of their gathers, a lamb for a house: <sup>4</sup>And if the household be too little for the lamb, let him and his neighbor next unto his house take it according to the number of the souls; every man according to his eating shall make you count for the lamb. <sup>5</sup>Your lamb shall be without blemish, a male of the first year: ye shall take it out from the sheep, or from the goats: <sup>6</sup>And ye shall keep it up until the fourteenth day of the same month: and the whole assembly of the congregation of Israel shall kill it in the evening.*

- **God commanded the lamb to be sacrificed in Jerusalem.**

**Deuteronomy 16:5** *Thou mayest not sacrifice the passover within any of thy gates, which the LORD thy God giveth thee: <sup>6</sup>But at the place which the LORD thy God shall choose to place his name in, there thou shalt sacrifice the passover at even, at the going down of the sun, at the season that thou camest forth out of Egypt.*

- **Jesus and the people fulfilled every prophecy!**

**Mark 11:1** *And when they came nigh to Jerusalem, unto Bethphage and Bethany, at the mount of Olives, he sendeth forth two of his disciples, <sup>2</sup>And saith unto them, Go your way into the village over against you: and as soon as ye be entered into it, ye shall find a colt tied, whereon*

never man sat; loose him, and bring him.<sup>3</sup> And if any man say unto you, *Why do ye this?* say ye **that the Lord hath need of him;** and straightway he will send him hither.<sup>4</sup> And they went their way, and found the colt tied by the door without in a place where two ways met; and they loose him.<sup>5</sup> And certain of them that stood there said unto them, *What do ye, loosing the colt?*<sup>6</sup> And they said unto them even as Jesus had commanded: and they let them go.

- **Lord save NOW!**

**John 12:12** *On the next day much people that were come to the feast, when they heard that Jesus was coming to Jerusalem,<sup>13</sup> Took branches of palm trees, and went forth to meet him, and cried, Hosanna: (LORD SAVE NOW) Blessed is the King of Israel that cometh in the name of the Lord.*

**Matthew 21:8** *And a very great multitude spread their garments in the way; others cut down branches from the trees, and strawed them in the way.<sup>9</sup> And the multitudes that went before, and that followed, cried, saying, Hosanna to the Son of David: Blessed is he that cometh in the name of the Lord; Hosanna in the highest.*

**Luke 19:36** *And as he went, they spread their clothes in the way.<sup>37</sup> And when he was come nigh, even now at the descent of the mount of Olives, the whole multitude of the disciples began to rejoice and praise God with a loud voice for all the mighty works that they had seen;<sup>38</sup> Saying, Blessed be the King that cometh in the name of the Lord: peace in heaven, and glory in the highest.<sup>39</sup> And some of the Pharisees from among the multitude said unto him, Master, rebuke thy disciples.<sup>40</sup> And he answered and said unto them, I tell you that, if these should hold their peace, the stones would immediately cry out.<sup>41</sup> And when he was come near, he beheld the city, and wept over it,*

- **JESUS WEEPING SAYS: (Luke 19:42-44)** *If thou hadst known, even thou, at least in this thy day, the things which belong unto thee peace! But now they are hid from thine eyes.<sup>43</sup> For the days shall come upon thee, that thine enemies shall cast a trench about thee, and compass thee round, and keep thee in on every side,<sup>44</sup> and shall lay thee even with the ground, and they children within thee; and they shall not leave in thee one stone upon another; **because thou knewest not the time of the visitation.***

**Mark 11:11** *And Jesus entered into Jerusalem, and into the temple: and when he had looked round about upon all things, and now the eventide was come, he went out unto Bethany with the twelve.*

- **Monday Jesus drives out the money changers**

<sup>12</sup> *And on the morrow, when they were come from Bethany, he was hungry:<sup>13</sup> And seeing a fig tree afar off having leaves, he came, if haply he might find any thing thereon: and when he came to it, he found nothing but leaves; for the time of figs was not yet.<sup>14</sup> And Jesus answered and said unto it, No man eat fruit of thee hereafter for ever. And his disciples heard it.<sup>15</sup> And they come to Jerusalem: and Jesus went into the temple, and began to cast out them that sold and bought in the temple, and overthrew the tables of the moneychangers, and the seats of them that sold doves;<sup>16</sup> And would not suffer that any man should carry any vessel through the temple.<sup>17</sup> And he taught, saying unto them, Is it not written, **My house shall be called of all nations the house of prayer?** but ye have made it a den of thieves.*

**After Jesus' Resurrection: Acts 1:6** *When they therefore were come together, they asked of him, saying, Lord, wilt thou at this time restore again the kingdom to Israel?<sup>7</sup> And he said unto them, It is not for you to know the times or the seasons, which the Father hath put in his own power.<sup>8</sup> But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.*

**Exodus 35:1** *And Moses gathered all the congregation of the children of Israel together, and said unto them, These are the words which the LORD hath commanded, that ye should do them. -----<sup>4</sup> And Moses spake unto all the congregation of the children of Israel, saying, This is the thing which the LORD commanded, saying,<sup>5</sup> **Take ye from among you an offering unto the LORD: whosoever is of a willing heart, let him bring it, an offering of the LORD; gold, and silver, and brass,---**<sup>20</sup> And all the congregation of the children of Israel departed from the presence of Moses.<sup>21</sup> **And they came, every one whose heart stirred him up, and every one whom his spirit made willing, and they brought the LORD'S offering to the work of the tabernacle of the congregation, and for all his service, and for the holy garments.<sup>22</sup> And they came, both men and women, as many as were willing hearted, and brought bracelets, and earrings, and rings, and tablets, all jewels of gold: and every man that offered offered an offering of gold unto the LORD!***
