Champion Be Released!

Text: 2 Corinthians 5:14 For the love of Christ constraineth us; because we thus judge, that if one died for all, then were all dead: 15 And that he died for all, that they which live should not henceforth live unto themselves, but unto him which died for them, and rose again. 16 Wherefore henceforth know we no man after the flesh: yea, though we have known Christ after the flesh, yet now henceforth know we him no more. 17 Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new. 18 And all things are of God, who hath reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ, and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation; 19 To wit, that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation. 20 Now then we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God did beseech you by us: we pray you in Christ's stead, be ye reconciled to God. 21 For he hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him.

Introduction: We all can see ourselves, others, and challenges from many different perspectives. Some have their point of view resulting from their past, others logically, while some people see life through:

- how the present effects them
- how they compare themselves to others
- emotional, physical, or financial fulfillment
- through fear
- ***God's Word

• "there is nothing I can do about it"

- "I just do as I am told"
- "everything is always my fault"

Today our viewpoint from God's Word has three expressions!

- 1. The Champion Attitude "I know no man after the flesh!"
- 2. The Champion Aptitude "I can do all things through Christ that strengthens me"
- 3. The Champion Action "God's Word never returns void!"
- 1. Attitude a settled way of thinking or feeling about someone or something, typically one that is reflected in a person's behavior:
 - a position of the body proper to or implying an action or mental state: *the boy was standing in an attitude of despair, his chin sunk on his chest.*
 - informal uncooperative behavior: I asked our server for a clean fork, and all I got was attitude.
- ***Christ centered confident attitude as manifested by behavior: Nothing affects me, I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me. Galatians 2:20

- 2. Aptitude is often aptitude for a natural or spiritual ability to do something: he had a remarkable aptitude for learning languages.
 - a natural tendency: his natural aptitude for failure.
 - Christ centered: I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me! Philippians 4:13
- 2 Corinthians 5:19 To wit, that God was in Christ, reconciling the world unto himself, not imputing their trespasses unto them; and hath committed unto us the word of reconciliation.

- 3. Action 2 Corinthians 4:13 We having the same spirit of faith, according as it is written, I believed, and therefore have I spoken; we also believe, and therefore speak;
- **John 14:12** Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father. ¹³ And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. ¹⁴ If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it.
