

## We Respond to Your Love Call

**Text: Acts 4:21** *So when they had further threatened them, they let them go, finding nothing how they might punish them, because of the people: for all men glorified God for that which was done. <sup>22</sup> For the man was above forty years old, on whom this miracle of healing was shewed. <sup>23</sup> And being let go, they went to their own company, and reported all that the chief priests and elders had said unto them. <sup>24</sup> And when they heard that, they lifted up their voice to God with one accord, and said, Lord, thou art God, which hast made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and all that in them is: <sup>25</sup> Who by the mouth of thy servant David hast said, Why did the heathen rage, and the people imagine vain things? <sup>26</sup> The kings of the earth stood up, and the rulers were gathered together against the Lord, and against his Christ. <sup>27</sup> For of a truth against thy holy child Jesus, whom thou hast anointed, both Herod, and Pontius Pilate, with the Gentiles, and the people of Israel, were gathered together, <sup>28</sup> For to do whatsoever thy hand and thy counsel determined before to be done. <sup>29</sup> And now, Lord, behold their threatenings: and grant unto thy servants, that with all boldness they may speak thy word, <sup>30</sup> By stretching forth thine hand to heal; and that signs and wonders may be done by the name of thy holy child Jesus. <sup>31</sup> And when they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and they spake the word of God with boldness. <sup>32</sup> And the multitude of them that believed were of one heart and of one soul: neither said any of them that ought of the things which he possessed was his own; but they had all things common. <sup>33</sup> And with great power gave the apostles witness of the resurrection of the Lord Jesus: and great grace was upon them all. <sup>34</sup> Neither was there any among them that lacked: for as many as were possessors of lands or houses sold them, and brought the prices of the things that were sold, <sup>35</sup> And laid them down at the apostles' feet: and distribution was made unto every man according as he had need. <sup>36</sup> And Joses, who by the apostles was surnamed Barnabas, (which is, being interpreted, The son of consolation,) a Levite, and of the country of Cyprus, <sup>37</sup> Having land, sold it, and brought the money, and laid it at the apostles' feet.*

- One in the crowd became one of His company – Barnabas introduces Saul as Apostle Paul to the other Apostles in Acts 9:27!

**Introduction: This is a significant week in God's Plan for your lives!**

- First, the outcome of our New Beginnings, "Love ordered my steps," established and empowered us to step out confidently in God's Love. We saw that **God's Come Back** always far exceeds any setbacks you have encountered!
- Now, we hear God calling you to be engaged with Victory and Jesus Experience to a corporate, supernatural week of fasting and prayer! His calling to be in one accord, moving in the same conviction, daily training and praying with one heart manifests His Love and Power!

**1. We, Your People, consecrate a week of Fasting and Prayer – Isaiah 58:6-14 "See Brochure"**

- On Daily Victory M - S, I will share specific exhortations and prayer thrusts!
- Then Friday, at 7 pm we join together for an awesome "Corporate Worship and Prayer Breakthrough."
- You may end your daily fast with Rev. Freke and Pastor KayCee in the lobby or on a zoom link for 30 minutes at 7 pm Monday through Saturday and 6 pm Sunday.

**2. God manifests when we join together.**

**In 2 Chronicles 19** Jehoshaphat had set Judges to bring order and justice throughout the cities of Judah and Priests to minister in Jerusalem. All that were under King Jehoshaphat's authority in Judah were finally seeing a new day until,

**2 Chronicles 20:1** *It came to pass after this also, that the children of Moab, and the children of Ammon, and with them other beside the Ammonites, came against Jehoshaphat to battle. <sup>2</sup> Then there came some that told Jehoshaphat, saying, There cometh a great multitude against thee from beyond the sea on this side Syria; and, behold, they be in Hazazontamar, which is Engedi.*

- Jehoshaphat's response to the threat –

<sup>3</sup> *And Jehoshaphat feared, and set himself to seek the LORD, and proclaimed a fast throughout all Judah.*

- All of the people joined together as one man

<sup>4</sup> *And Judah gathered themselves together, to ask help of the LORD: even out of all the cities of Judah they came to seek the LORD.*

- Jehoshaphat's prayer in the congregation

<sup>5</sup> *And Jehoshaphat stood in the congregation of Judah and Jerusalem, in the house of the LORD, before the new court, <sup>6</sup> And said, O LORD God of our fathers, art not thou God in heaven? and rulest not thou over all the kingdoms of the heathen? and in thine hand is there not power and might, so that none is able to withstand thee? <sup>7</sup> Art not thou our God, who didst drive out the inhabitants of this land before thy people Israel, and gavest it to the seed of Abraham thy friend for ever? <sup>8</sup> And they dwelt therein, and have built thee a sanctuary therein for thy name,*

saying, <sup>9</sup> *If, when evil cometh upon us, as the sword, judgment, or pestilence, or famine, we stand before this house, and in thy presence, (for thy name is in this house,) and cry unto thee in our affliction, then thou wilt hear and help.* <sup>10</sup> *And now, behold, the children of Ammon and Moab and mount Seir, whom thou wouldst not let Israel invade, when they came out of the land of Egypt, but they turned from them, and destroyed them not; **Behold, I say, how they reward us, to come to cast us out of thy possession, which thou hast given us to inherit.*** <sup>12</sup> ***O our God, wilt thou not judge them? for we have no might against this great company that cometh against us; neither know we what to do: but our eyes are upon thee.*** <sup>13</sup> *And all Judah stood before the LORD, with their little ones, their wives, and their children.*

- **Jehoshaphat acknowledged human weakness - OUR eyes are steadfast on the Lord – Romans 8:23-28**

<sup>14</sup> *Then upon Jahaziel the son of Zechariah, the son of Benaiah, the son of Jeiel, the son of Mattaniah, a Levite of the sons of Asaph, came the Spirit of the LORD in the midst of the congregation; <sup>15</sup> And he said, Harken ye, all Judah, and ye inhabitants of Jerusalem, and thou king Jehoshaphat, Thus saith the LORD unto you, Be not afraid nor dismayed by reason of this great multitude; for the battle is not yours, but God's. .... Believe in the LORD your God, so shall ye be established; believe his prophets, so shall ye prosper.* <sup>21</sup> *And when he had consulted with the people, he appointed singers unto the LORD, and that should praise the beauty of holiness, as they went out before the army, and to say, Praise the LORD; for his mercy endureth for ever. <sup>22</sup> And when they began to sing and to praise, the LORD set ambushments against the children of Ammon, Moab, and mount Seir, which were come against Judah; and they were smitten. <sup>23</sup> For the children of Ammon and Moab stood up against the inhabitants of mount Seir, utterly to slay and destroy them: and when they had made an end of the inhabitants of Seir, every one helped to destroy another.*

- **Multigenerational wealth transfer –**

**Luke 11:20** *But if I with the finger of God cast out devils, no doubt the kingdom of God is come upon you. <sup>21</sup> When a strong man armed keepeth his palace, his goods are in peace: <sup>22</sup> But when a stronger than he shall come upon him, and overcome him, he taketh from him all his armour wherein he trusted, and divideth his spoils.*

**2 Chronicles 20:24** *And when Judah came toward the watch tower in the wilderness, they looked unto the multitude, and, behold, they were dead bodies fallen to the earth, and none escaped. <sup>25</sup> And when Jehoshaphat and his people came to take away the spoil of them, they found among them in abundance both riches with the dead bodies, and precious jewels, which they stripped off for themselves, more than they could carry away: and they were three days in gathering of the spoil, it was so much. <sup>26</sup> And on the fourth day they assembled themselves in the valley of Berachah; for there they blessed the LORD: therefore the name of the same place was called, The valley of Berachah, unto this day.*

- **Celebration of the great Triumph of the Lord – Next Sunday morning we will have a Hallel “High Praise!” In Jewish names it means “Cry of Joy!”**

<sup>27</sup> *Then they returned, every man of Judah and Jerusalem, and Jehoshaphat in the forefront of them, to go again to Jerusalem with joy; for the LORD had made them to rejoice over their enemies. <sup>28</sup> And they came to Jerusalem with psalteries and harps and trumpets unto the house of the LORD. <sup>29</sup> And the fear of God was on all the kingdoms of those countries, when they had heard that the LORD fought against the enemies of Israel. <sup>30</sup> So the realm of Jehoshaphat was quiet: for his God gave him rest round about.*

**Haggai 2:6** *For thus saith the LORD of hosts; Yet once, it is a little while, and I will shake the heavens, and the earth, and the sea, and the dry land; <sup>7</sup> And I will shake all nations, and the desire of all nations shall come: and I will fill this house with glory, saith the LORD of hosts. <sup>8</sup> The silver is mine, and the gold is mine, saith the LORD of hosts. <sup>9</sup> The glory of this latter house shall be greater than of the former, saith the LORD of hosts: and in this place will I give peace, saith the LORD of hosts.*

**Haggai 2:15** *And now, I pray you, consider from this day and upward, from before a stone was laid upon a stone in the temple of the LORD:*

- **Honor God with that which is His nothing less**

**Haggai 2:16** *Since those days were, when one came to an heap of twenty measures, there were but ten: when one came to the pressfat for to draw out fifty vessels out of the press, there were but twenty. <sup>17</sup> I smote you with blasting and with mildew and with hail in all the labours of your hands; yet ye turned not to me, saith the LORD. <sup>18</sup> Consider now from this day and upward, from the four and twentieth day of the ninth month, even from the day that the foundation of the LORD'S temple was laid, consider it. <sup>19</sup> Is the seed yet in the barn? yea, as yet the vine, and the fig tree, and the pomegranate, and the olive tree, hath not brought forth: from this day will I bless you.*
