3. Action according to God's Chosen Fast:

Find a need in the Body and fill it!

Isaiah 58:6 Is not this the fast that I have chosen?

- To loose the bands of wickedness.
- To undo the heavy burdens, and
- To let the oppressed, go free, and
- That ye break every yoke?

7 Is it not to

- Deal thy bread to the hungry, and that thou
- Bring the poor that are cast out to thy house?
- When thou seest the naked, that thou cover him; and
- That thou hide not thyself from thine own flesh? (Don't hide from your family)
- ⁸ Then shall thy light break forth as the morning, and thine health shall spring forth speedily: and thy righteousness shall go before thee; the glory of the LORD shall be thy reward.
 - ⁹ Then shalt thou call, and the LORD shall answer; thou shalt cry, and he shall say, Here I am.
 - If thou take away from the midst of thee the yoke,
 - The putting forth of the finger, and
 - Speaking vanity;
 - ¹⁰ And if thou draw out thy soul to the hungry, and
 - Satisfy the afflicted soul;
 - then shall thy light rise in obscurity, and thy darkness be as the noonday:

4. Worship God with your first-fruits, tithes and alms and honor God with your substance.

Proverbs 3:9 Honour the LORD with thy substance, and with **the firstfruits** of all thine increase: ¹⁰ So shall thy barns be filled with plenty, and thy presses shall burst out with new wine.

Malachi 3:10 *Bring ye all the tithes* into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house, and prove me now herewith, saith the LORD of hosts, if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it. ¹¹ And I will rebuke the devourer for your sakes, and he shall not destroy the fruits of your ground; neither shall your vine cast her fruit before the time in the field, saith the LORD of hosts. ¹² And all nations shall call you blessed: for ye shall be a delightsome land, saith the LORD of hosts. ¹³ Your words have been stout against me, saith the LORD. Yet ye say, What have we spoken so much against thee? ¹⁴ Ye have said, It is vain to serve God: and what profit is it that we have kept his ordinance, and that we have walked mournfully before the LORD of hosts? ¹⁵ And now we call the proud happy; yea, they that work wickedness are set up; yea, they that tempt God are even delivered. ¹⁶ Then they that feared the LORD spake often one to another: and the LORD hearkened, and heard it, and a book of remembrance was written before him for them that feared the LORD, and that thought upon his name. ¹⁷ And they shall be mine, saith the LORD of hosts, in that day when I make up my jewels; and I will spare them, as a man spareth his own son that serveth him. ¹⁸ Then shall ye return, and discern between the righteous and the wicked, between him that serveth God and him that serveth him not.
