1. Pray God's Word

Keep praying His promises, not your problems, reminding both yourself and God of His faithfulness.

- 2 Peter 1:3 According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue: ⁴ Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.
- **Isaiah 62:6-7** Ye that are the Lord's remembrancers, take ye no rest, and give Him no rest, till He establish, and till He make Jerusalem a praise in the earth. —
- Luke 11:5 And he said unto them, Which of you shall have a friend, and shall go unto him at midnight, and say unto him, Friend, lend me three loaves; ⁶ For a friend of mine in his journey is come to me, and I have nothing to set before him? ⁷ And he from within shall answer and say, Trouble me not: the door is now shut, and my children are with me in bed; I cannot rise and give thee. ⁸ I say unto you, Though he will not rise and give him, because he is his friend, yet because of his importunity he will rise and give him as many as he needeth. ⁹ And I say unto you, Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you. ¹⁰ For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened.

3. Action according to God's Chosen Fast:

Fasting and prayer is not for your purpose but His!

Isaiah 58:4 Behold, ye fast for strife and debate, and to smite with the fist of wickedness: ye shall not fast as ye do this day, to make your voice to be heard on high.

Isaiah 58:6 Is not this the fast that I have chosen?

- To loose the bands of wickedness,
- To undo the heavy burdens, and
- To let the oppressed, go free, and
- That ye break every yoke?

⁷ Is it not to

- Deal thy bread to the hungry, and that thou
- Bring the poor that are cast out to thy house?
- When thou seest the naked, that thou cover him; and
- That thou hide not thyself from thine own flesh? (Don't hide from your family)

⁸ Then shall thy light break forth as the morning, and thine health shall spring forth speedily: and thy righteousness shall go before thee; the glory of the LORD shall be thy reward.

- ⁹ Then shalt thou call, and the LORD shall answer; thou shalt cry, and he shall say, Here I am.
- If thou take away from the midst of thee the yoke,
- The putting forth of the finger, and
- Speaking vanity;
- ¹⁰ And if thou draw out thy soul to the hungry, and
- Satisfy the afflicted soul;
- then shall thy light rise in obscurity, and thy darkness be as the noonday:

4. Worship God with your first-fruits, tithes and alms and honor God with your substance.

2 Corinthians 9:6 But this I say, He which soweth sparingly shall reap also sparingly; and he which soweth bountifully shall reap also bountifully. ⁷ Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver. ⁸ And God is able to make all grace abound toward you; that ye, always having all sufficiency in all things, may abound to every good work: ⁹ (As it is written, He hath dispersed abroad; he hath given to the poor: his righteousness remaineth for ever. ¹⁰ Now he that ministereth seed to the sower both minister bread for your food, and multiply your seed sown, and increase the fruits of your righteousness;) ¹¹ Being enriched in every thing to all bountifulness, which causeth through us thanksgiving to God.
