

## Palm Sunday – 2023

**Matthew 21:1** *And when they drew nigh unto Jerusalem, and were come to Bethphage, unto the mount of Olives, then sent Jesus two disciples, <sup>2</sup> Saying unto them, Go into the village over against you, and straightway ye shall find an ass tied, and a colt with her: loose them, and bring them unto me. <sup>3</sup> And if any man say ought unto you, ye shall say, The Lord hath need of them; and straightway he will send them. <sup>4</sup> All this was done, that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophet, saying, <sup>5</sup> Tell ye the daughter of Sion, Behold, thy King cometh unto thee, meek, and sitting upon an ass, and a colt the foal of an ass. <sup>6</sup> And the disciples went, and did as Jesus commanded them, <sup>7</sup> And brought the ass, and the colt, and put on them their clothes, and they set him thereon. <sup>8</sup> And a very great multitude spread their garments in the way; others cut down branches from the trees, and strawed them in the way. <sup>9</sup> And the multitudes that went before, and that followed, cried, saying, Hosanna to the Son of David: Blessed is he that cometh in the name of the Lord; Hosanna in the highest.*

**Zechariah 9:9 NLT** - *Rejoice, O people of Zion!*

*Shout in triumph, O people of Jerusalem!*

*Look, your king is coming to you.*

*He is righteous and victorious,  
yet he is humble, riding on a donkey—  
riding on a donkey's colt.*

<sup>10</sup> *I will remove the battle chariots from Israel and the warhorses from Jerusalem.*

*I will destroy all the weapons used in battle,  
and your king will bring peace to the nations.*

*His realm will stretch from sea to sea  
and from the Euphrates River to the ends of the earth.*

<sup>11</sup> *Because of the covenant I made with you,  
sealed with blood,*

*I will free your prisoners  
from death in a waterless dungeon.*

<sup>12</sup> *Come back to the place of safety,  
all you prisoners who still have hope!*

*I promise this very day  
that I will repay two blessings for each of your troubles.*

- **Just before Passover “Thursday” the King /the Lamb of God enters Jerusalem!**
- **3 years earlier John the Baptist when he saw Jesus coming he cried “Behold the Lamb of God!” John 1:29**

### PASSOVER WAS ALWAYS A FAMILY EVENT!

- **Passover for 1500 YEARS celebrated a lamb for a house; if the house is too small, include others! - Exodus 12:3**
- **Christ our Passover! - 1 Corinthians 5:7** *Purge out therefore the old leaven, that ye may be a new lump, as ye are unleavened. For even Christ our passover is sacrificed for us:*

### Revelation Knowledge of Jesus' SACRIFICE - "ALL IS Poured OUT ON HIM"

**All 4 Gospels record the anointing of Jesus' Head and Feet for His burial. Matthew and Mark concur the same anointing where Judas went out -**

**Mark 14:3** *And being in Bethany in the house of Simon the leper, as he sat at meat, there came a woman having an alabaster box of ointment of spikenard very precious; and she brake the box, and poured it on his head. <sup>4</sup> And there were some that had indignation within themselves, and said, Why was this waste of the ointment made? <sup>5</sup> For it might have been sold for more than three hundred pence, and have been given to the poor. And they murmured against her. <sup>6</sup> And Jesus said, Let her alone; why trouble ye her? she hath wrought a good work on me. <sup>7</sup> For ye have the poor with you always, and whensoever ye will ye may do them good: but me ye have not always. <sup>8</sup> She hath done what she could: she is come aforehand to anoint my body to the burying. <sup>9</sup> Verily I say unto you, Wheresoever this gospel shall be preached throughout the whole world, this also that she hath done shall be spoken of for a memorial of her. <sup>10</sup> And Judas Iscariot, one of the twelve, went unto the chief priests, to betray him unto them.*
