RIGHTEOUSNESS: YOUR KEY TO FREEDOM

TEXT: Rom. 5:17

INTRODUCTION

Most people battle with thoughts such as "I'm not now, nor will I ever be good enough"; "Because of what I did, God can't do what He promised"; "I'm always wanting to do what is right, but I never do things exactly right."

To summarize, these are thoughts of insecurity or inferiority. Jesus released us from these feelings and all symptoms of competition and comparison with others. This release occurred because He took your sin-dominated life and gave you His life and right relationship with your Father God, which cannot be broken.

Today, we will believe together for the revelation knowledge on the topic of righteousness.

I. THE NEW PLAN: GUILTLESS RIGHTEOUSNESS

- A. Righteousness--the ability to stand in the presence of God without the sense of guilt, inferiority, or insecurity--just as if sin never existed.
 - 1. Guilt produces shame.
 - 2. Inferiority is being subordinate to a person or situation, which appears to overpower you.
 - 3. Insecurity is experiencing more fear than is warranted.
 - 4. Righteousness has come without the law.

B. Righteousness is to sinners by faith.

- 1. Every one is entitled to it by belief.
- 2. No difference between Jew and Gentile
- 3. Everyone has sinned.

- C. We are declared righteous by grace through Jesus' blood.
 - 1. Through God's goodness, Jesus paid the ransom.
 - 2. Through Jesus' blood, your sins are remitted and you are legally "not guilty" because you believe.

TEXT: 1 Pet. 2:24

INTRODUCTION

The foundational truth of God's power to heal is just as true as forgiveness of sins. This segment of teaching will explore healing from the origin of disease to the biblical ways that healing occurs. Open hour heart to the truth that Jesus took sickness and pain upon His body for you at Calvary. Believe God with me for the Lord to use you also to heal the sick.

I. THE ORIGIN OF SICKNESS

- A. Adam's sin exposed the human race to sickness and death.
 - 1. Pre-Fall--No sickness, no death
 - Post-Fall--Sickness and death ruled man through Satan's influence

B. Sickness is a result of Satan's work.

C. People, prior to salvation, are children of the devil, and he has clear access to them.

1 John 3:8

D. Sickness in a believer's life does not automatically mean that there is sin in that person's life.

- 1. Does not mean you are demon possessed
- 2. Does not mean you will not go to heaven
- 3. Does not mean that you are less of a Christian

II. GOD IS THE HEALER IN THE OLD TESTAMENT AS WELL AS THE NEW

IV. JESUS' WILL IS TO HEAL ALL KINDS OF SICKNESS

A. Jesus is God's will in action.

He healed one person, it is settled that it is God's will to

heal all.

- E. Whenever you pray, believe that it is always God's will to heal everyone with any or every disease.
- V. BECAUSE SICKNESS' ORIGIN IS WITH THE DEVIL AND MAN'S BODY IS DESIGNED TO FIGHT DISEASE, THERE IS NO CONDEMNATION FOR HEALING COMING THROUGH OTHER MEANS
 - A. Diet, vitamins, exercise, or therapy

- B. Sleep or rest
- C. Medicine or vaccinations
- D. Hospitals, doctors, dentists, or surgeons

*All are fighting the same enemy!

PRINCIPLES THAT UNLOCK ABUNDANCE

TEXT: 3 John 2; Pro. 10:22

INTRODUCTION

Most of the prayer requests that come into the ministry are for family and finances, and many of the family challenges are due to money. God's Word has the answer, and if these truths are applied, you and your family will step into God's abundance. First, you must remove all preconceived opinions and ideas about money, especially the religious ones!

Believe with me that God's promises will be manifested.

I. HAVE THE RIGHT PERSPECTIVE OF MONEY

Steward = one who manages another's property, finances, or affairs

1. God calls us to account of how we managed what is His.

- 3. Your goal should not be to make a living on the earth but to live for the Creator and Owner of the earth.

THE CHURCH THAT JESUS BUILT

INTRODUCTION

Depending on your background, the word "church" will mean different things. So, when one person's understanding differs from another's, you end up with <u>division</u>, or separate visions. You have very limited agreement, so that the church is not able to move in power.

This segment of **THE UNSHAKABLE FOUNDATION** will lay the biblical basis for His Church and empower us to agree and act together in great authority and purpose.
