## **Daily Gratitude Produces a Lifetime of Joy**

**Text: 1 Thessalonians 5:18** *In everything give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.* 

**Introduction:** When you consciously decide to turn the reactions into Gratitude you plant seeds for a future of Blessings and Joy!

The renewed mind with a harnessed tongue reaps a lifetime of Blessings and JOY!

Galatians 6:7 Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap. 8 For he that soweth to his flesh shall of the flesh reap corruption; but he that soweth to the Spirit shall of the Spirit reap life everlasting. 9 And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not.

Today intentionally write down three things that you are grateful for:

- 1. Gratitude for God's Grace

Psalms 100:4 Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, and into his courts with praise: be thankful unto him, and bless his name. <sup>5</sup> For the LORD is good; his mercy is everlasting; and his truth endureth to all generations.

James 1:17 Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning. <sup>18</sup> Of his own will begat he us with the word of truth, that we should be a kind of firstfruits of his creatures. <sup>19</sup> Wherefore, my beloved brethren, let every man be swift to hear, slow to speak, slow to wrath:

Colossians 3:15 And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to the which also ye are called in one body; and be ye thankful. <sup>16</sup> Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom; teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the Lord. <sup>17</sup> And whatsoever ye do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God and the Father by him.

## 2. Gratitude for people

Philippians 1:3 I thank my God upon every remembrance of you, <sup>4</sup> always in every prayer of mine making request for you all with joy, <sup>5</sup> for your fellowship in the gospel from the first day until now, <sup>6</sup> being confident of this very thing, that He who has begun a good work in you will complete it until the day of Jesus Christ;

Romans 1:8 First, I thank my God through Jesus Christ for you all, that your faith is spoken of throughout the whole world.

• Decree the full benefits of Grace to every person

**John 20:23** Whose soever sins ve remit, they are remitted unto them; and whose soever sins ve retain, they are retained.

• Steer relationships with gratitude

James 3:1-18 (NLT) {turn in your Bible}

- 3. Gratitude for circumstances
- Everything works for you!

**Romans 8:28** And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose.

• Speak God's Word not circumstances

**2** Corinthians 4:13 We having the same spirit of faith, according as it is written, I believed, and therefore have I spoken; we also believe, and therefore speak; <sup>14</sup> Knowing that he which raised up the Lord Jesus shall raise up us also by

Jesus, and shall present us with you. <sup>15</sup> For all things are for your sakes, that the abundant grace might through the thanksgiving of many redound to the glory of God. <sup>16</sup> For which cause we faint not; but though our outward man perish, yet the inward man is renewed day by day. <sup>17</sup> For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, worketh for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory;

4. Gratitude renews your mind

1 Thessalonians 5:18 In everything give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.

Romans 12:2 And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God.

- End categorical statements such as "They <u>always and never"</u>, "I hope they get a taste of their own medicine", or "What comes around goes around" etc.
- 5. Gratitude Journaling
- Daily Structure:

People: Who did you bless today?

Circumstances: What challenge revealed God's grace?

Attitude: What mindset shift did you experience?

- Scripture Reflection: Include a verse that speaks to your gratitude.
- Prayer of Thanks: End each entry with a short prayer.

## Worship God through your First-Fruits, Tithes, Alms, and Sacrifices ----- With Thanksgiving!

**2 Corinthians 9:6 (AMP)** Now [remember] this: he who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and he who sows generously [that blessings may come to others] will also reap generously [and be blessed]. <sup>7</sup>Let each one give [thoughtfully and with purpose] just as he has decided in his heart, not grudgingly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver [and delights in the one whose heart is in his gift]. 8 And God is able to make all grace [every favor and earthly blessing] come in abundance to you, so that you may always [under all circumstances, regardless of the need] have complete sufficiency in everything [being completely self-sufficient in Him], and have an abundance for every good work and act of charity. <sup>9</sup> As it is written and forever remains written, "He [the benevolent and generous person] scattered abroad, he gave to the poor, His righteousness endures forever!" <sup>10</sup> Now He who provides seed for the sower and bread for food will provide and multiply your seed for sowing [that is, your resources] and increase the harvest of your righteousness [which shows itself in active goodness, kindness, and love]. 11 You will be enriched in every way so that you may be generous, and this [generosity, administered] through us is producing thanksgiving to God [from those who benefit]. <sup>12</sup> For the ministry of this service (offering) is not only supplying the needs of the saints (God's people), but is also overflowing through many expressions of thanksgiving to God. <sup>13</sup> Because of this act of ministry, they will glorify God for your obedience to the gospel of Christ which you confess, as well as for your generous participation [in this gift] for them and for all [the other believers in need], 14 and they also long for you while they pray on your behalf, because of the surpassing measure of God's grace [His undeserved favor, mercy, and blessing which is revealed] in you. <sup>15</sup> Now thanks be to God for His indescribable gift [which is precious beyond words]!
