



# THE CROSS AND BLOOD MANIFEST POWER



## The Cross & Blood Manifest Power

**Text: 1 Corinthians 1:18** *For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which are saved it is the power of God.* <sup>19</sup> *For it is written, I will destroy the wisdom of the wise, and will bring to nothing the understanding of the prudent.----* <sup>27</sup> *But God hath chosen the foolish things of the world to confound the wise; and God hath chosen the weak things of the world to confound the things which are mighty;* <sup>28</sup> *And base things of the world, and things which are despised, hath God chosen, yea, and things which are not, to bring to nought things that are:* <sup>29</sup> *That no flesh should glory in his presence.*

**Introduction:** God has mandated that through the spoken word of Jesus' Cross and Blood, His Power would be manifested! Today, we will unlock His Power and experience manifestation of what Jesus died to end in your life. We must understand the difference between the nature of sin and the act of sinning. Also, understand the difference of Jesus' Death and Jesus' Blood. Remember the enemy is working to stop you, your family and all that you will ever know from knowing God and His Grace in POWER! Jesus won the war of sin consciousness in your life!

**Hebrews 10:10** *By the which will we are sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all.* <sup>11</sup> *And every priest standeth daily ministering and offering oftentimes the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins:* <sup>12</sup> *But this man, after he had offered one sacrifice for sins for ever, sat down on the right hand of God;* <sup>13</sup> *From henceforth expecting till his enemies be made his footstool.* <sup>14</sup> *For by one offering he hath perfected for ever them that are sanctified.* <sup>15</sup> *Whereof the Holy Ghost also is a witness to us: for after that he had said before,* <sup>16</sup> *This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, saith the Lord, I will put my laws into their hearts, and in their minds will I write them;* <sup>17</sup> *And their sins and iniquities will I remember no more.* <sup>18</sup> *Now where remission of these is, there is no more offering for sin.* <sup>19</sup> *Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the holiest by the blood of Jesus,* <sup>20</sup> *By a new and living way, which he hath consecrated for us, through the veil, that is to say, his flesh;* <sup>21</sup> *And having an high priest over the house of God;* <sup>22</sup> *Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water.* <sup>23</sup> *Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; (for he is faithful that promised;)* <sup>24</sup> *And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works.*

### 1. Sin vs Sins

- a. Sin – the nature, the root, the power
- b. Sins – the acts, the fruit, the behavior

Jesus' Death dealt with both and we must act in faith on both for true freedom to manifest in our lives.

### 2. Jesus' Death is the end of Sin nature

- a. Satan the first with a sin nature

**Ezekiel 28:15** *Thou wast perfect in thy ways from the day that thou wast created, till iniquity was found in thee.*

- b. Through Adam sin nature passed to all mankind

**Romans 5:12** *Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned:*

**Romans 6:23** *For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.*

- c. Jesus died to sin nature once

**Romans 6:9** *Knowing that Christ being raised from the dead dieth no more; death hath no more dominion over him.* <sup>10</sup> *For in that he died, he died unto sin once: but in that he liveth, he liveth unto God.*

- d. You in Jesus died to sin nature once

**Romans 6:6** *Knowing this, that our old man is crucified with him, that the body of sin might be destroyed, that henceforth we should not serve sin.* <sup>7</sup> *For he that is dead is freed from sin.* <sup>8</sup> *Now if we be dead with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with him:* <sup>9</sup> *Knowing that Christ being raised from the dead dieth no more; death hath no more dominion over him.* <sup>10</sup> *For in that he died, he died unto sin once: but in that he liveth, he liveth unto God.* <sup>11</sup> *Likewise reckon ye also yourselves to be dead indeed unto sin, but alive unto God through Jesus Christ our Lord.*

- **ACKNOWLEDGE AND SPEAK BOLDLY: SIN NATURE YOU ARE DEAD IN ME!**

**Galatians 2:20** *I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me.* <sup>21</sup> *I do not frustrate the grace of God: for if righteousness come by the law, then Christ is dead in vain.*

**Colossians 3:3** *For ye are dead, and your life is hid with Christ in God.*

e. We acknowledge that Jesus' Death is applied to all

2 Corinthians 5:14 *For the love of Christ constraineth us; because we thus judge, that if one died for all, then were all dead:*

- **ACKNOWLEDGE AND SPEAK BOLDLY: THE NATURE OF SIN IS DEAD IN OTHERS THROUGH JESUS' DEATH!**

3. Jesus' Blood satisfied God's judgment against your sins

Romans 3:25 (NLT) *For God presented Jesus as the sacrifice for sin. People are made right with God when they believe that Jesus sacrificed his life, shedding his blood. This sacrifice shows that God was being fair when he held back and did not punish those who sinned in times past,*

Romans 3:25 (YLT) *whom God did set forth a mercy seat, through the faith in his blood, for the shewing forth of His righteousness, because of the passing over of the bygone sins in the forbearance of God --*

a. Jesus' Blood forgave your sins

Ephesians 1:7 *In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace;*

Isaiah 43:25 (NIV) *I, even I, am he who blots out your transgressions, for my own sake, and remembers your sins no more.*

Psalms 103:12 *As far as the east is from the west, so far has he removed our transgressions from us.*

Isaiah 1:18 (NIV) *Come now, let us settle the matter, says the Lord. Though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they are red as crimson, they shall be like wool.*

- **DECLARE BOLDLY - "I AM FORGIVEN and I FORGIVE MYSELF IN JESUS' NAME!"**

b. Through Jesus' Blood forgive others sins

John 20:23 *Whose soever sins ye remit (forgive), they are remitted unto them; and whose soever sins ye retain, they are retained.*

2 Corinthians 2:10 (NLT) *When you forgive this man, I forgive him, too. And when I forgive whatever needs to be forgiven, I do so with Christ's authority for your benefit*

2 Corinthians 2:10 *To whom ye forgive any thing, I forgive also: for if I forgave any thing, to whom I forgave it, for your sakes forgave I it in the person of Christ;*

- **DECLARE BOLDLY I FORGIVE ( ? ) THROUGH JESUS' BLOOD AND THE PERSON OF JESUS!**

4. We war against the accuser

Revelation 12:9 *And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and Satan, which deceiveth the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him. <sup>10</sup> And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of his Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down, which accused them before our God day and night. <sup>11</sup> And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death.*

<sup>12</sup> *Therefore rejoice, ye heavens, and ye that dwell in them. Woe to the inhabitants of the earth and of the sea! for the devil is come down unto you, having great wrath, because he knoweth that he hath but a short time.*

- **IT IS YOUR TIME TO FIGHT!**

2 Corinthians 10:3 (NKJV) *For though we walk in the flesh, we do not war according to the flesh. <sup>4</sup> For the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, <sup>5</sup> casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ,*

- **TESTIMONY – Elyon & Dionna**

Worship God with your First-Fruits, Tithes and Sacrifices:

Malachi 3:10 *Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house, and prove me now herewith, saith the LORD of hosts, if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it. <sup>11</sup> And I will rebuke the devourer for your sakes, and he shall not destroy the fruits of your ground; neither shall your vine cast her fruit before the time in the field, saith the LORD of hosts. <sup>12</sup> And all nations shall call you blessed: for ye shall be a delightsome land, saith the LORD of hosts.*
