Declare Boldly: "Lord Save Now!" - Palm Sunday 2026

Text: Zechariah 9:9 *Rejoice greatly, O daughter of Zion; shout, Oh daughter of Jerusalem: behold, thy King cometh unto thee: he is just, and **having salvation**; lowly, and riding upon an ass, and upon a colt the foal of an ass.*

Psalms 118:25 *Save now, I beseech thee, O LORD: O LORD, I beseech thee, send now prosperity. ²⁶ Blessed be he that cometh in the name of the LORD: we have blessed you out of the house of the LORD.*

Introduction: As Jesus left the mount of olives, **Matthew 21:8** *And a very great multitude spread their garments in the way; others cut down branches from the trees, and strawed them in the way. ⁹And the multitudes that went before, and that followed, **cried, saying, Hosanna (Lord Save Now!) to the Son of David: Blessed is he that cometh in the name of the Lord; Hosanna in the highest.***

Previously, in Luke 19:11 *And as they heard these things, he added and spake a parable, because he was nigh to Jerusalem, and because they thought that the kingdom of God should immediately appear: -Parable of the 10 Talents to carry on business like a banker through trading.*

Today we are called to experience The Kingdom of God in Power! We must see what Jesus said to do to experience His Power and multiply His life in others!

1. Through Jesus' sacrifice He provided everything you could ever ask to receive!
2. Jesus raised us with Him to give us all that He has!
3. We are sent as the Father sent Jesus.
4. When we pray, we release His Power from within to those who are receiving in Jesus' Name!

1. Through Jesus' sacrifice He provided everything you could ever ask to receive!

John 19:28 (NKJV) *After this, Jesus, **knowing that all things were now accomplished, that the Scripture might be fulfilled**, said, "I thirst!" ²⁹ Now a vessel full of sour wine was sitting there; and they filled a sponge with sour wine, put it on hyssop, and put it to His mouth. ³⁰ So when Jesus had received the sour wine, He said, "**It is finished!**" And bowing His head, He gave up His spirit.*

- **Jesus died to save, heal, deliver and prosper**

Romans 5:8 *But God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that **while we were still sinners, Christ died for us.***

Isaiah 53:3 (YLT) *He is despised, and left of men, A man of pains, and acquainted with sickness, And as one hiding the face from us, He is despised, and we esteemed him not. ⁴ **Surely our sicknesses he hath borne, And our pains -- he hath carried them, And we -- we have esteemed him plagued, Smitten of God, and afflicted. ⁵ And he is pierced for our transgressions, Bruised for our iniquities, The chastisement of our peace [is] on him, And by his bruise there is healing to us.***

2 Corinthians 8:9 *For ye know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that, though he was rich, yet for your sakes he became poor, that ye through his poverty might be rich.*

- **Jesus reconciled everything**

Colossians 1:19 *For it pleased the Father that in Him all the fullness should dwell, ²⁰ and by Him to reconcile all things to Himself, by Him, whether things on earth or things in heaven, having made peace through the blood of His cross.*

- **Jesus raised again having conquered hell and death!**

Revelation 1:17 *And when I saw him, I fell at his feet as dead. And he laid his right hand upon me, saying unto me, Fear not; I am the first and the last: ¹⁸ **I am he that liveth, and was dead; and, behold, I am alive for evermore, Amen; and have the keys of hell and of death.***

Colossians 2:12 *Buried with him in baptism, wherein also ye are risen with him through the faith of the operation of God, who hath raised him from the dead. ¹³ And you, being dead in your sins and the uncircumcision of your flesh, hath he quickened (Made Alive!) together with him, having forgiven you all trespasses; ¹⁴ Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross; ¹⁵ **And having spoiled principalities and powers, he made a show of them openly, triumphing over them in it.***

Phillips Trans V15 *And then having drawn the sting of all the powers ranged against us, he exposed them, shattered, empty and defeated, in his final glorious triumphant act!*

2. Jesus raised us with Him to give us all that He has!

Matthew 28:18 (After Jesus rose) *And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth.*

Ephesians 2:6 *and raised us up together, and made us sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, ⁷ that in the ages to come He might show the exceeding riches of His grace in His kindness toward us in Christ Jesus. ⁸ For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, ⁹ not of works, lest anyone should boast. ¹⁰ For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them.*

3. We are sent as the Father sent Jesus

John 20:21 (NKJV) *So Jesus said to them again, "Peace to you! As the Father has sent Me, I also send you."*

4. When we pray, we release His Power from within to those who are receiving in Jesus' Name!

- We are for signs, wonders and greater works

Isaiah 8:18 *Behold, I and the children whom the LORD hath given me are for signs and for wonders in Israel from the LORD of hosts, which dwelleth in mount Zion*

John 14:12 *Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father. ¹³ And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son.*

- **Receive Power!**

Acts 1:8 *But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.*

Isaiah 61:1 *The Spirit of the Lord GOD is upon me; because the LORD hath anointed me to preach good tidings unto the meek; he hath sent me to bind up the brokenhearted*, to proclaim liberty to the captives, and the opening of the prison to them that are bound;*

Matthew 16:18 (NKJV) *And I also say to you that you are Peter, and on this rock I will build My church, and the gates of Hades shall not prevail against it. ¹⁹ And I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth ^[b]will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven.*

Mark 16:17 *And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; ¹⁸ They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.*

- Today we release the power of God in Jesus' Name to all that will receive salvation, baptism in the Holy Spirit, healing, deliverance, financial freedom, freedom from every form of bondage emotionally, mentally, and spiritually!

John 7:37 *In the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried, saying, If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink. ³⁸ He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water. ³⁹ (But this spake he of the Spirit, which they that believe on him should receive: for the Holy Ghost was not yet given; because that Jesus was not yet glorified.)*

Ephesians 3:20 *Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us, ²¹ to Him be glory in the church by Christ Jesus to all generations, forever and ever. Amen.*
