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## The Name That Wins It All

The nature of God is fully revealed in Jesus. We have the delegated, legal authority to use that name and because of Jesus, we experience the victory in every battle.

Over the last four weeks, we've explored the magnificent nature of God: The mystery of the Trinity, Jehovah Rapha (The Lord who Heals), Jehovah Shalom (The Lord our Peace), Jehovah Nissi (The Lord our Banner), Jehovah Tsidkenu (The Lord our Righteousness) and Jehovah Jireh (The Lord our Provider).

Every healing, every peace, every victory, our righteousness and every provision pointed to one name: Jesus. This isn't just theology for me. When I buried my firstborn son and grief tried to swallow me, all I had was one name to cry out, JESUS. When doctors diagnosed me with lupus and kidney disease, I called on the name Jesus and God healed me. When I moved across the world in 2002 with no support system, that name anchored me. And just this past week, when they told me my 13-year-old son had bone cancer and we cried out in the name of Jesus, the diagnosis was overturned. We just came through a major family battle and we won the victory!

The name of Jesus is not a ritual. It is a weapon; it is the full nature of God placed in your mouth, giving you the legal authority to break every bondage and overcome the impossible.

As Pastor Gary teaches, "The power of God is in your mouth. You have the single absolute authority in your mouth that is the power to expose and liberate everything and when you use it you get the results." Today, we are going to use it and get results.

### 1. The Name That Contains the Fullness of God

Everything Jehovah is, Jesus is. The Trinity isn't a distant concept; God took on flesh so that the name of Jesus would become the legal conduit to release the power of God.

**Acts 3:1-16 NLT** *One day Peter and John were going up to the temple at the time of prayer—at three in the afternoon. <sup>2</sup> Now a man who was lame from birth was being carried to the temple gate called Beautiful, where he was put every day to beg from those going into the temple courts. <sup>3</sup> When he saw Peter and John about to enter, he asked them for money. <sup>4</sup> Peter looked straight at him, as did John. Then Peter said, "Look at us!" <sup>5</sup> So the man gave them his attention, expecting to get something from them. <sup>6</sup> Then Peter said, "Silver or gold I do not have, but what I do have I give you. In the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, walk." <sup>7</sup> Taking him by the right hand, he helped him up, and instantly the man's feet and ankles became strong. <sup>8</sup> He jumped to his feet and began to walk. Then he went with them into the temple courts, walking and jumping, and praising God. <sup>9</sup> When all the people saw him walking and praising God, <sup>10</sup> they recognized him as the same man who used to sit begging at the temple gate called Beautiful, and they were filled with wonder and amazement at what had happened to him. <sup>11</sup> While the man held on to Peter and John, all the people were astonished and came running to them in the place called Solomon's Colonnade. <sup>12</sup> When Peter saw this, he said to them: "Fellow Israelites, why does this surprise you? Why do you stare at us as if by our own power or godliness we had made this man walk? <sup>13</sup> The God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob, the God of our fathers, has glorified his servant Jesus. You handed him over to be killed, and you disowned him before Pilate, though he had decided to let him go. <sup>14</sup> You disowned the Holy and Righteous One and asked that a murderer be released to you. <sup>15</sup> You killed the author of life, but God raised him from the dead. We are witnesses of this. <sup>16</sup> By faith in the name of Jesus, this man whom you see and know was made strong. It is Jesus' name and the faith that comes through him that has completely healed him, as you can all see.*

**Colossians 2:9 NLT** *For in Christ lives all the fullness of God in a human body.*

**John 14:9 ESV** *Jesus said...Whoever has seen me has seen the Father...*

**Hebrews 1:3 NLT** *The Son radiates God's own glory and expresses the very character of God...*

When you call on the name of Jesus, you aren't hoping to get a little piece of God. You are legally accessing the fullness. Jehovah Rapha, Shalom, Jireh, Nissi are all wrapped up in one name.

Pastor Gary explains that God has already designed a transfer method.

The question is, "How does God transfer what is stored in Heaven to you on Earth?"

The answer is the incarnate Word. Jesus is the "Yes and Amen." Everything stored in Heaven; every healing, every provision is transferred through the name of Jesus.

### 2. The Name Jesus Carries Supreme Authority

Because Jesus humbled Himself to death on a cross, God exalted Him to the highest place and invested absolute authority in His name. This authority isn't just a fact; it's a legal tool He has delegated to us.

**Philippians 2:9-11 NLT** *Therefore, God elevated him to the place of highest honor and gave him the name above all other names, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue declare that Jesus Christ is Lord...*

**Matthew 28:18 ESV** *All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me.*

**Proverbs 18:21 ESV** *Death and life are in the power of the tongue, and those who love it will eat its fruits.*

This is a legal transaction. When you speak the name, you are not just making noise. The power of God is in your mouth. It is the single absolute authority to expose and liberate everything.

Think of it as a legal power of attorney. Jesus has all the stock in heaven, but He gave you the legal right to make transfers with His Name.

### 3. **The Name That Breaks Every Chain (The Legal Transfer)**

Using the name of Jesus isn't passive. It is the legal enforcement of a covenant. It's how we dismantle strongholds, reverse diagnoses, and break generational curses.

**Acts 3:6, 16 NLT** *But Peter said, 'I don't have any silver or gold for you. But I'll give you what I have. In the name of Jesus Christ the Nazarene, get up and walk!' ... <sup>16</sup>'Through faith in the name of Jesus, this man was healed.'*

**Luke 10:19 ESV** *Behold, I have given you authority to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall hurt you."*

**Isaiah 45:23 NLT** *I have sworn by my own name; I have spoken the truth, and I will never go back on my word: Every knee will bend to me, and every tongue will declare allegiance to me.*

When the doctor spoke the names "lupus" and "bone cancer," those were names of death trying to write a program. But we used our legal right! We cried out the name of Jesus, and the diagnosis had to bow.

God transfers to you what is already reserved in Heaven. Healing is already reserved for us in Heaven.

The transfer happens when you 'call those things that be not as though they were' with the name of Jesus.

You aren't begging God to send healing; you are exercising your legal right to pull what is already stored in Heaven into the Earth.

There is a "but" you add to every bad report: "They say this isn't curable, BUT in the name of Jesus, I am healed." That is the authority in your mouth exposing and liberating your situation.

Don't deny the situation, just speak the truth that is higher than the situation.

### 4. **The Name That Secures Unshakable Victory**

We don't fight for the right to be free; we fight with that right already won at Calvary. That means even your personal family battles, your grief, and your struggle to adapt to new seasons are already under the feet of Jesus.

**I Corinthians 15:57 NLT** *But thank God! He gives us victory over sin and death through our Lord Jesus Christ.*

**Romans 8:37 ESV** *No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us.*

**Revelation 12:11 NLT** *And they have defeated him by the blood of the Lamb and by their testimony...*

Because the authority is legally ours, we don't just survive battles; we conquer them. I'm a testimony that the grief of losing a son and the shock of a lupus diagnosis didn't end me. Why? Because I didn't let grief and sickness write the program. I used my mouth to declare Jesus.

We must know "how God transfers what is stored in Heaven to you on Earth." It is already stored up for you.

Our victory over this family battle was stored up before the foundation of the world. We just had to call it in.

Whatever impossible situation you are facing right now, the verdict has already been rendered: "It is finished."

We enforce that verdict here and now with the Name of Jesus.

We're not just going to leave here informed; we're going to leave here transformed. Let's use the Name of Jesus and watch God do what He has promised He would do.
